Dear Friend of the Rogue Roundup:

As you are likely aware, the Oregon Governor's office issued a mandate, curtailing public gatherings of more than 25 people. In order to be responsible and conform to the best and prevailing wisdom of our public healthcare officials, the Roundup is cancelling our May 2020 gathering. For those who are already registered we are offering refunds, or transfer registrations to the 2021 Roundup.

This is the only time in our entire 45 years that we have not hosted this event and we would like you to know this decision was not made lightly. The health of our members and community are important. There is a real possibility the ban would not be lifted prior to April 30 (the first day of Rogue Roundup). The timing is such that speaker travel and participation cannot be guaranteed (impacting future Roundup planning); we would have to pay the fairgrounds and other Roundup expenses if we do not cancel now.

We will be providing updates on our website as we journey through this together. Like all of you, we look forward to returning to a familiar life. We are looking forward to an amazing 2021 Rogue Roundup event, which our Board and Committee we will be planning throughout the coming year.
